1	Person(s) assigned at the entrance points to carry out screening of worshippers			
2	Functional Thermo Guns at entry areas			
3	Visibly mounted notice on screening of worshippers;			
4	Visibly mounted notice on promotion of hand hygiene and physical distancing			
5	Visibly mounted notice on denial of entry of suspected COVID-19 cases			
6	Notice indicating mandatory donning of face masks			
7	Washrooms and ablution areas to remain closed			
8	Worshippers to maintain social distancing at all times (1 metre – 3 feet) in and outside the temple			

9	Disinfection of the temples to be undertaken after every prayer session			
10	Floor markings to guide the physical distancing within the temple			
11	Adequate ventilation and lighting			
12	Proof of hand washing facilities with soap or hand sanitizers at all entry/exit points			
13	Worshippers not share mala (prayer beads)			
14	Evidence that once the temple is full to capacity with social distance maintained, other worshippers coming in are restricted			
15	Ring of bells and touching of idols is not allowed			
16	Offering flowers, milk and oil not allowed but cashless giving like Mpesa is encouraged			
17	Children not allowed inside in the temple and should be left at home.			
18	Availability and evidence of implementation of Standard Operating Procedures (SOPs) for cleaning & disinfection			
19	Disinfectants, cleaning equipment and detergent			
20	Trained cleaners assigned for cleaning and disinfection duty roster			
21	Standard Operating Procedures (SOPs) for reporting illness			
22	Holding room for suspected Covid-19 cases			
23	Comprehensive register of worshipers with their contact details maintained
