	Worshippers will be encouraged to leave the premises soon after the end of the service and not remain to socialize		
	Proof of cashless way of giving offertories e.g. Mpesa or paybill number		
15	Disinfection of the church to be undertaken after every service.		
16	Toilets and ablution blocks to be cleaned with disinfectant at regular intervals		
17	Disinfectants, cleaning equipment and detergents must be present		
18	Availability and evidence of implementation of Standard Operating Procedures (SOPs) for cleaning and disinfection		
19	Trained cleaners assigned for cleaning and disinfection duty roster		
20	Standard Operating Procedures (SOPs) for reporting illness		
21	Holding room for suspected Covid-19 cases		
22	Comprehensive register of worshipers with their contact details maintained
